SUBJECT: Answers No. 3 to Bidders Questions as of the date of this letter, per 00100-IFB Article 1.(3)(C).

The following are answers to Bidders received on the above project. These answers do not modify the Contract. Any modifications to the Contract will be through Addenda

Q-1: Section 01015 - Please indicate which activities listed throughout this section will be subject to the Austin Water Concurrence Review process requiring AW Director Level approvals.

A-1: Dependent on contractor means and methods and shutdown durations, concurrence process may require AW Director Level approvals.

Q-2: Section 01015, Paragraph 3.04.E, discusses bypass pumping during influent line tie-ins. Can existing influent lines be taken out of service for any period of time? If not, what are the flow conditions per line so bypass pumping can be sized adequately?

A-2: This will be addressed by Addendum No. 4.

Q-3: During coordinated existing headworks shutdowns, will there still be constant sludge flows running through the (2) 12" lines and 8" line from SAR WWTP, Walnut Creek WWTP and the Side Stream Plant?

A-3: This will be addressed by Addendum No. 4.

Q-4: On Sheet C-8, on the profiles for WWL-B and WWL-C, the existing line that is to be connected to the new WWL-A is shown to be a "10" DI WWL" The tee for WWL-A connection is an 8"x8". Is this existing line 8" or 10"?

A-4: This will be addressed by Addendum No. 4.

Q-5: On Sheet C-7, NPW-A and NPW-B are shown to be 2" HDPE. The schedule on Sheet M-1 shows that small diameter NPW buried pipe does not allow for HDPE. Should this be PVC instead?

A-5: This will be addressed by Addendum No. 4.

Q-6: Please check the scale on sheet C-14, the actual measurements for the silt fence are half of what is shown.

A-6: This will be addressed by Addendum No. 4.



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Q-7: Section 15 of the Instructions to Bidders: "Accordingly, a partnership/joint venture must file its partnership/joint venture agreement, a corporation must file its articles and bylaws, a limited liability company must file its certificate of organization and article of organization and regulations, and a limited partnership must file not only limited partnership agreement and the certificate of limited partnership, but also the documentation for its general partner, and any Bidder must file a copy of any assumed name certificate, or such limited portion of such documents reasonably establishing signature authority." Does a Corporate Resolution satisfy this?

A-7: Yes.

Q-8: Instructions to Bidders repeats calls to Section 00820, which we cannot find in any of the bid documents. Where can we find this section/is that applicable to our bids/was it taken out of the packet?

A-8: Section 00820 is not applicable to this project.

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
